



Single stream recycling is now in use here. You do not have to separate bottles and cans from paper, and can throw it all mixed together into any of our recycling bins. It now gets sorted out later.

## WHAT TO RECYCLE:

**NO PLASTIC BAGS PLEASE \* NO GARBAGE \* NO OFFSITE ORIGINATED MATERIALS**

MATERIAL TYPE	DO RECYCLE	<u>DO NOT RECYCLE</u>
<b>Single Stream Recycling:</b>		
Cardboard	Corrugated cardboard with the “wiggly” center used for packing boxes and boxes made from recycled cardboard. Cut and/or bundle tied	Plastic inserts and packing material from cardboard boxes. Laundry soapboxes, pizza boxes.
Paper	White and colored writing paper, computer paper, and direct mail, shredded paper, in “clear” bags	Gift wrap, paper towels, napkins, tissues, or paper plates
Magazines	Softbound magazines or catalogs, bundle tied or in paper bags	Hardbound books
Newspaper	Newspaper and newspaper inserts, bundle tied or in paper bags	
Aluminum Cans	Food and tuna cans, soda and beer cans.	Food, or pie cooking/baking trays, or aluminum foil wrap
Glass	Juice bottles, beer and wine bottles, baby food jars, and other glass food and beverage containers any color.	Light bulbs, ceramics, or car or home window glass
Metal Cans	Food cans that hold soup, vegetables, pet food, and tuna	
Plastic Bottles and Jugs	Plastic bottles and jugs, such as 2-liter soda and detergent bottles, and milk jugs	<b>Please, no</b> motor oil containers, plastic bags (with exception of clear bags), Styrofoam, Juice boxes/packets.

All recycling goes in our bins. A trash can is there for small plastic bags used to bring the materials to the recycling center. We encourage you to return grocery store plastic bags to the stores for recycling, or utilize reusable bags to help the environment.

## OTHER WASTE ITEMS

**Household garbage pickups** are made by our contractor Mondays and Thursdays, except for major holidays. Makeup collections may be made related to some holidays; you will be advised on our website [SHLtoday.org](http://SHLtoday.org) or in our Newsletter if this is the case.

Do not place garbage outside earlier than 5 AM on collection day. Collections may start as early as 7 AM. Use heavy plastic bags; black is best for protection against birds and squirrels. Place the bags on the sidewalk in front of your unit; do not place them in the roadway, parking area or on the grass. Do not store garbage on balconies, patios, behind bushes or in common areas, under penalty of fine!



If you don't get the garbage out in time, the Association does not provide special pickups. While site maintenance staff endeavors to provide one follow-through after each court's pickup, your neighbors will appreciate your watching out for birds and squirrels picking into bags, and picking up any loose material so it does not blow around!

Outside trash cans are NOT allowed, but residents are now authorized to place this storage seat/lid to store garbage on their patio or balcony. Specifications are: twenty-two gallon, white or tan resin, approx. 24" H x 22"W x 17.5"D. Available online or in local stores.

- **Bulky items** like carpeting, old furniture, and wooden doors should be placed with the regular garbage on Thursdays.
- **White goods** -- refrigerators, stoves, dishwashers, water heaters, bed frames, and other large metal items. Call Lawrence Township Public Works at 844-7137, and they will schedule a special Wednesday pickup. Note, doors must be removed from appliances for safety reasons.
- Large bulky items ONLY may be placed in your assigned parking place awaiting pickup, close to your curb but NEVER where they may be close to the open roadway where they could be a danger to passing cars or close to any adjacent space. THINK SAFETY!
- DO NOT leave any of the above items at the Recycling area.

**Violations of any garbage or recycling rules are subject to fines or corrective orders! Please be considerate.**
